

Passaic River, New Jersey Environmental Restoration

Resolved by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the United States House of Representatives, That the Secretary of the Army is requested to review the report of the Chief of Engineers on the Passaic River Mainstem project, New Jersey and New York, published as House Document 163, 101st Congress, 1st Session, and other pertinent reports to determine the feasibility of improvements that would restore the Passaic River, including adjacent river shorelines, in urban areas which have been subject to repeated degradation as a result of historic and ongoing industrial and commercial activities and urban development, in the interest of the greater ecological health and economic revitalization of the region.
