#### **Survey Methodology**

- Conducted March 9 December 7, 2023, among a probability sample of 20,799 adults who are part of the Ipsos Knowledge Panel plus 1,666 state level opt-in oversamples, for a total sample of 22,465 adults.
- The margin of error for the full sample is +/- 0.82 percentage points and has a design effect of 1.56.
- The survey was made possible through the generous support of the Carnegie Corporation of New York, the Foundation to Promote Open Society, the Wilbur & Hilda Glenn Family Foundation, and the Unitarian Universalist Veatch Program at Shelter Rock.




### **Statements Constituting the Christian Nationalism Scale**

U.S. laws should be based on Christian values.	39




#### The Christian Nationalism Scale





FIGURE 3. Support for Christian Nationalism (Adherents and Sympathizers), by State






#### Support for Christian Nationalism, by Red, Blue, and Battleground States

FIGURE 6. Relationship Between Christian Nationalism and Vote for Donald Trump in 2020, by State






## Support for Christian Nationalism, by Party Affiliation and Candidate Favorability








#### Support for Christian Nationalism, by Religious Tradition





#### **Support for Christian Nationalism, by Religious Attendance**




#### Theological Beliefs, by Support for Christian Nationalism

Because things have gotten so far off track, true American patriots may have to resort to violence in order to save our country



# How Race and Ethnicity Impact the Political Orientations of Christian Nationalists




#### Party Affiliation, by Support for Christian Nationalism and Race


#### Views of Trump and Biden, by Support for Christian Nationalism and Race
