Survey Methodology


- Conducted February 28-March 20, 2025, among a representative sample of 5,025 adults who are part of the Ipsos KnowledgePanel and an additional 372 who were recruited by Ipsos using opt-in survey panels to increase the sample sizes in smaller states.
- The margin of error for the full sample is +/- 1.69 percentage points.




Voter Remorse, by Presidential Vote Choice








Trump Job Performance, by Party








Trump Favorability Over Time, by Party









Trump Favorability, by Religious Affiliation

Percent who have very or somewhat favorable views of Donald Trump:








Trump Favorability, 2024 vs. 2025, Among Hispanic Americans














Support for Postponing Midterm Elections and Allowing Presidents to Serve Three Terms, by Party





Support for Executive Exemptions to the Rule of Law, by Party






Support for the President Ignoring Congress and Courts, by Party

Oppose: The establishment of a federal task force that focuses exclusively on discrimination against Christians rather than discrimination against all religions.


Oppose: Closing or drastically shrinking all major federal agencies, if it means things like airline travel, medicine, and water may be less safe.

■ Favor: The U.S. Constitution's existing guarantee that all children who are born in the United States are automatically granted U.S. citizenship.



Percent who oppose the establishment of a federal task force that focuses exclusively on discrimination against Christians rather than discrimination against all religions:







Opposition to Elon Musk's Role in the Federal Government

- Agree: Elon Musk's attempts to find waste and fraud in federal government agencies are reckless and are doing more harm than good.










