## Survey Methodology

---

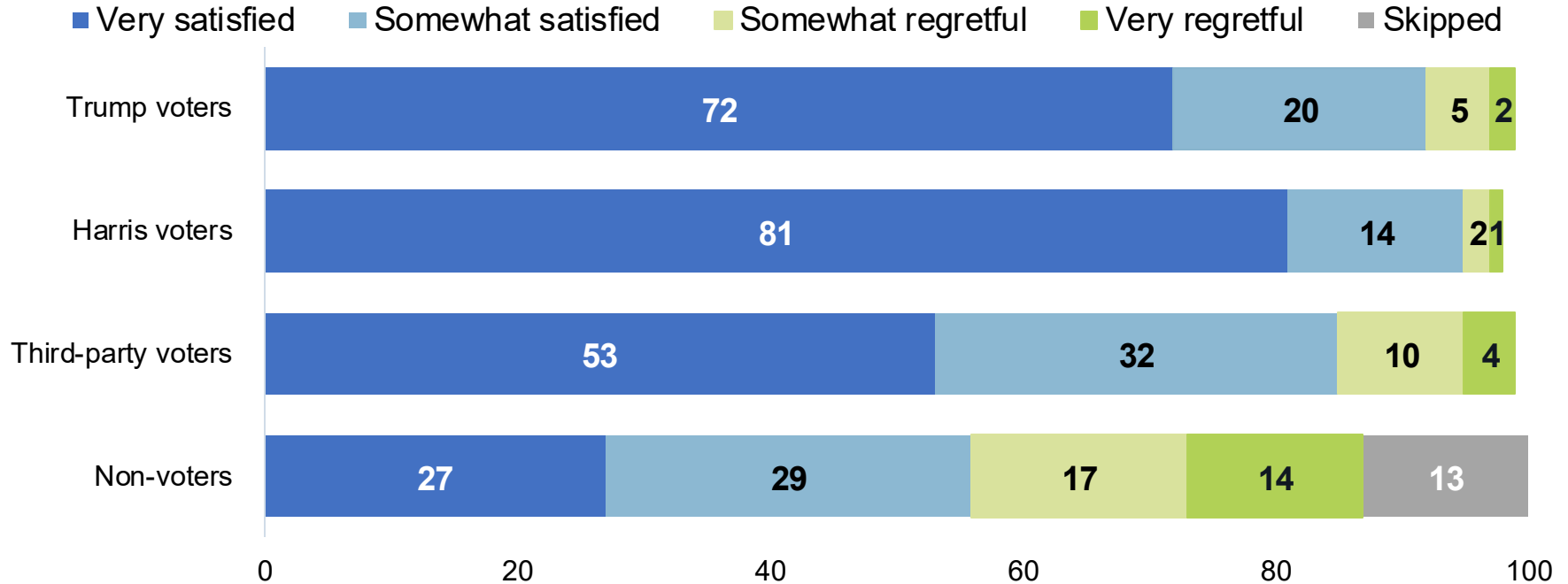
- Conducted February 28-March 20, 2025, among a representative sample of 5,025 adults who are part of the Ipsos KnowledgePanel and an additional 372 who were recruited by Ipsos using opt-in survey panels to increase the sample sizes in smaller states.
- The margin of error for the full sample is +/- 1.69 percentage points.

# Voter Remorse, by Presidential Vote Choice

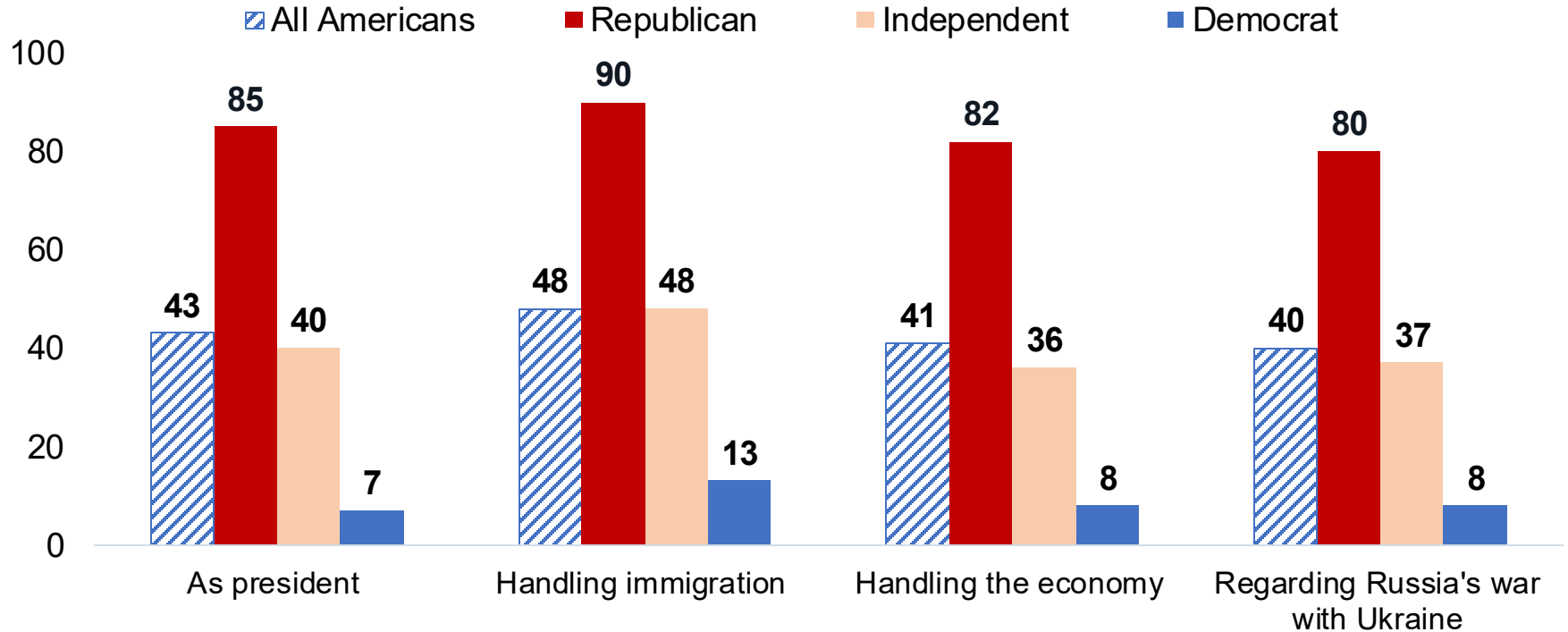
Percent who say they feel \_\_\_ with their vote decision in the 2024 presidential election:

# Trump Job Performance, by Party

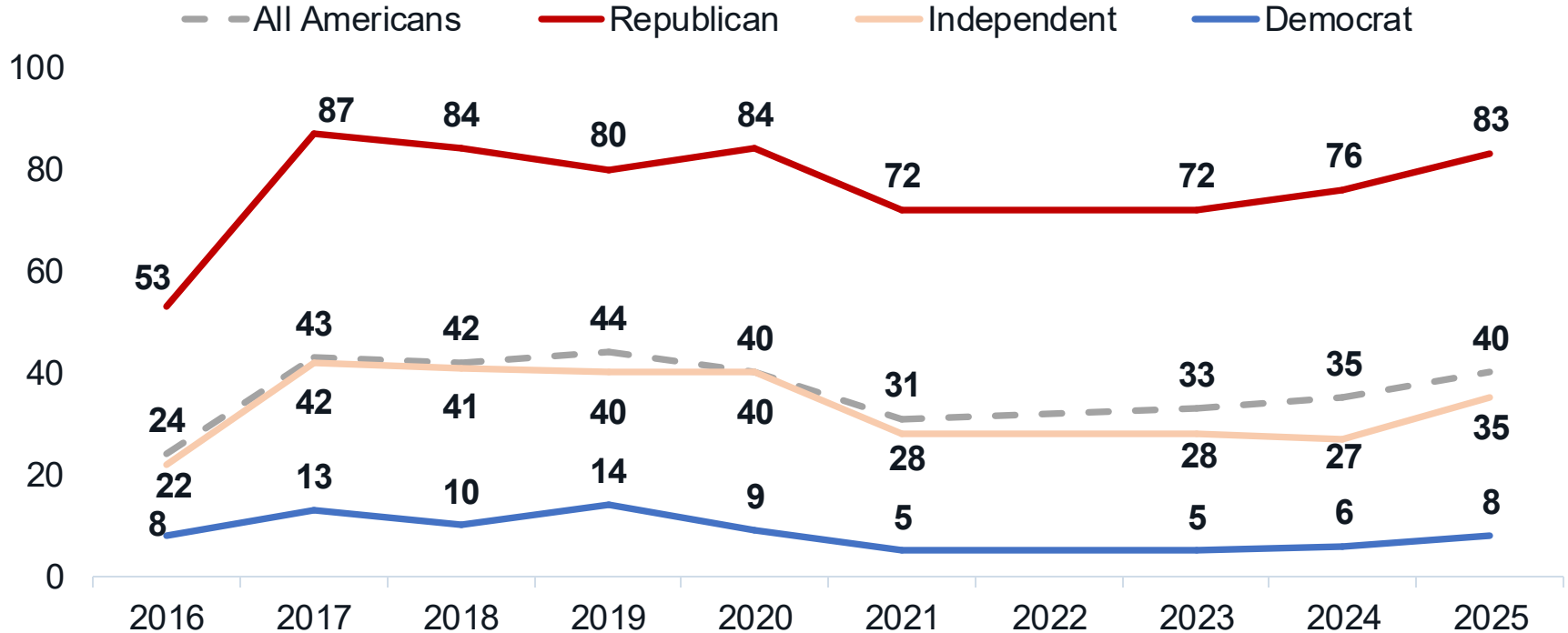
*Percent who approve of the job Donald Trump is doing:*

# Trump Favorability Over Time, by Party

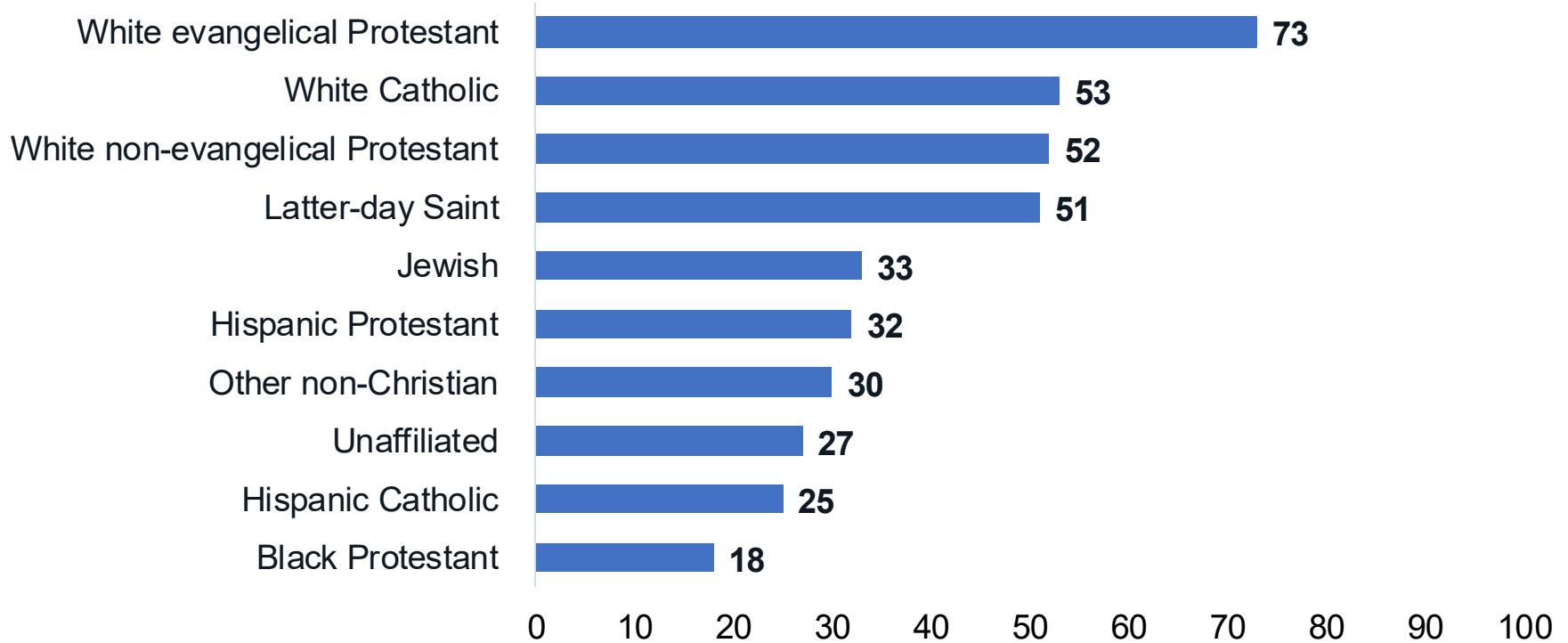
*Percent who have very or somewhat favorable views of Donald Trump:*

*Percent who have very or somewhat favorable views of Donald Trump:*

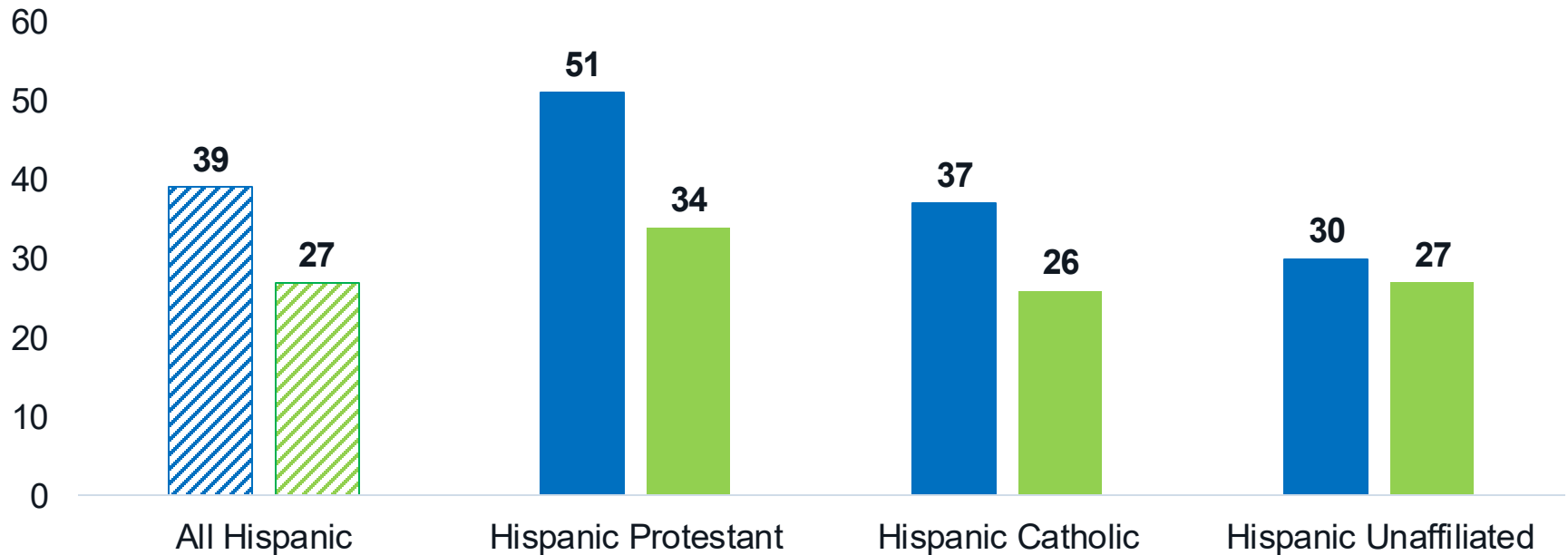

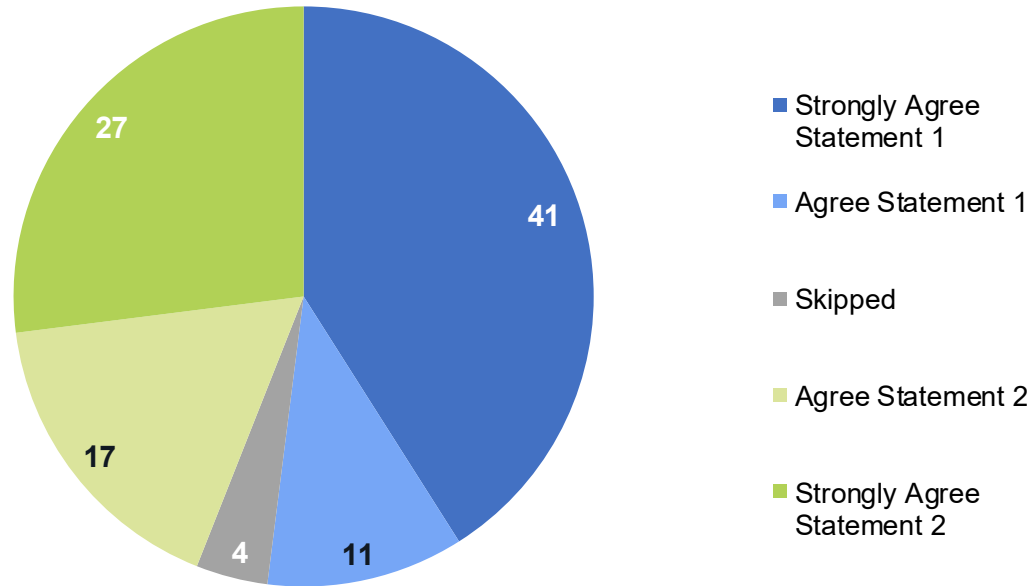

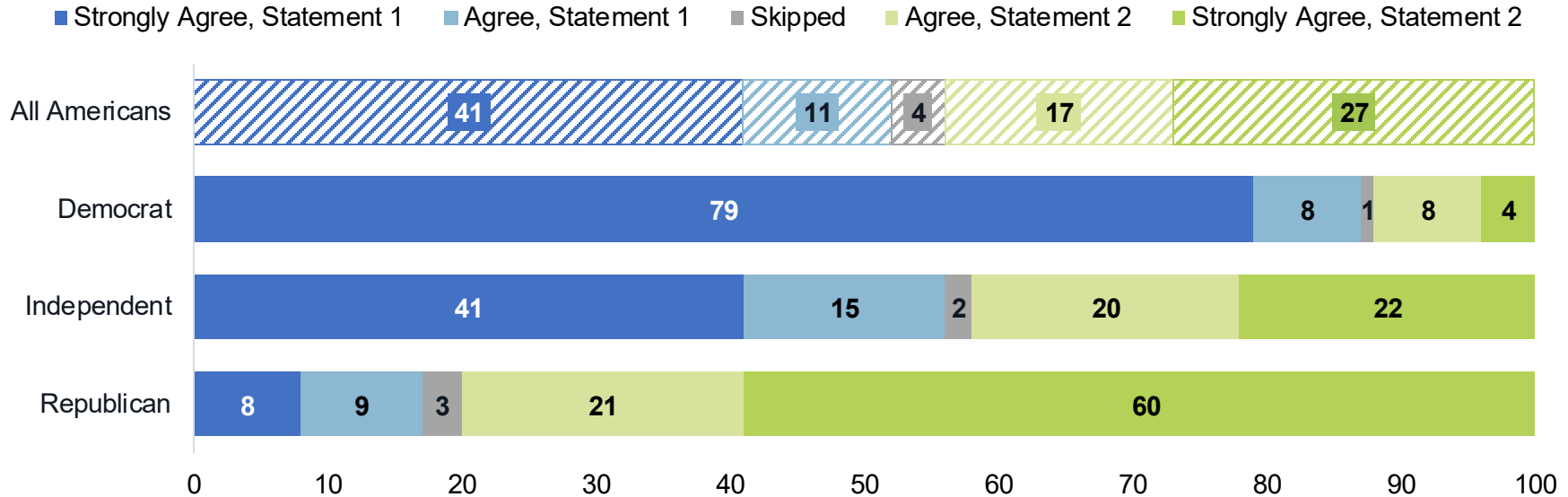

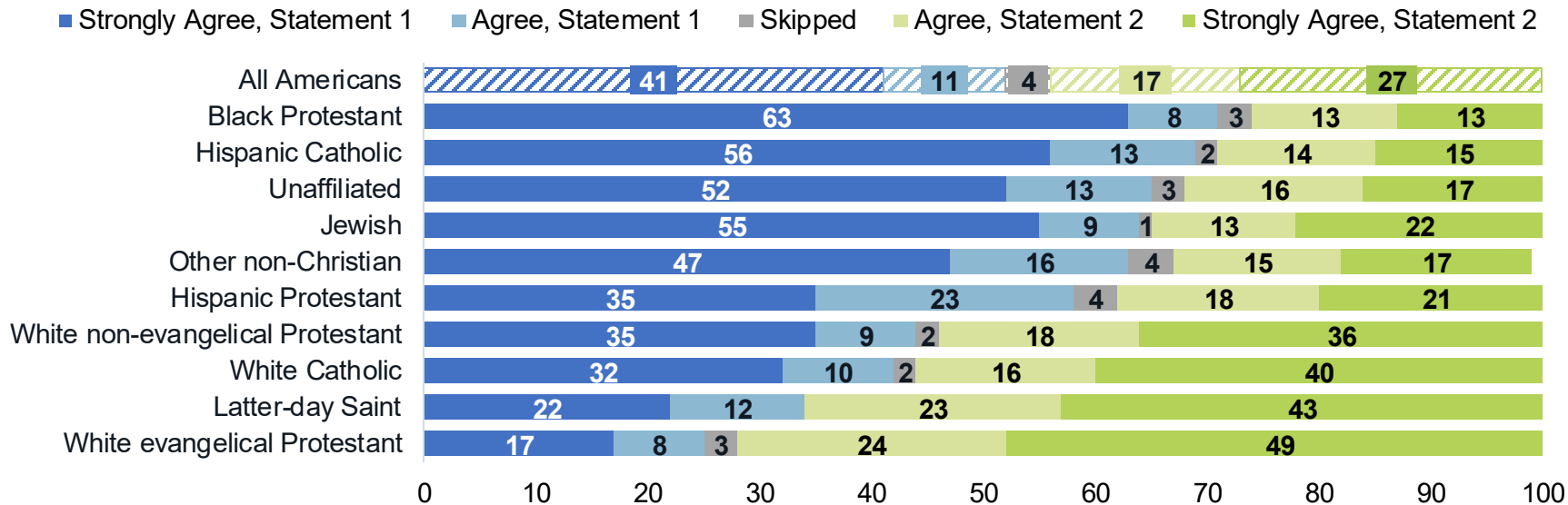

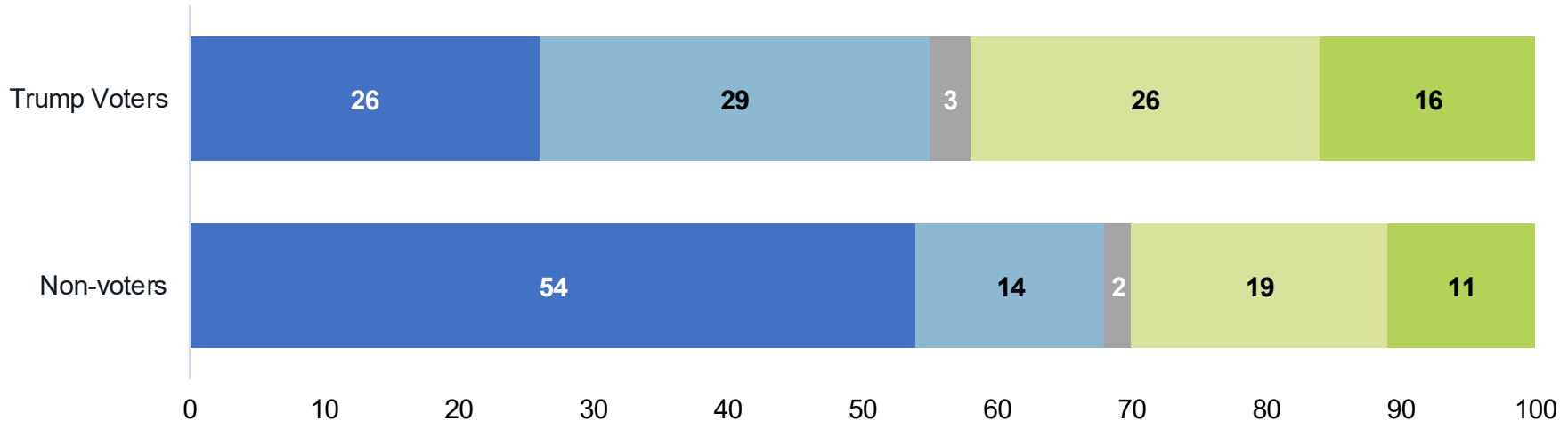

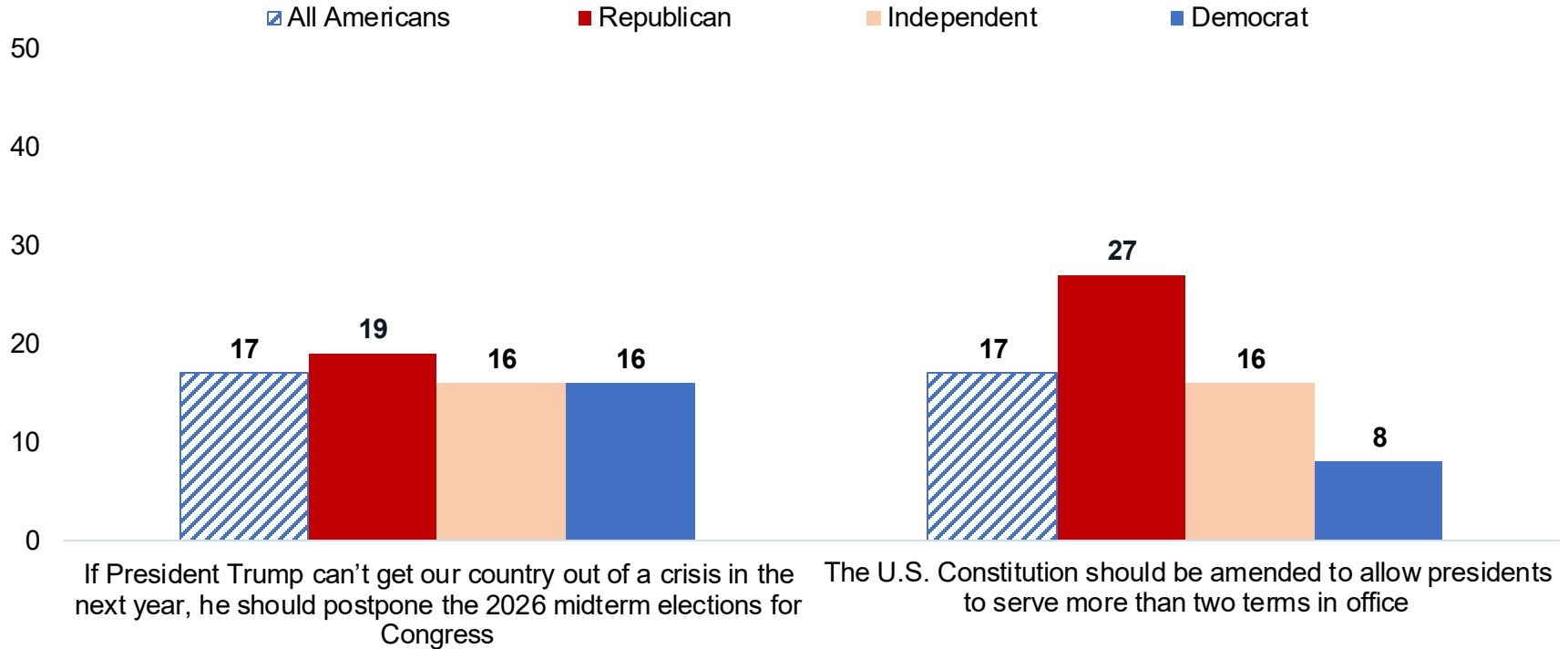

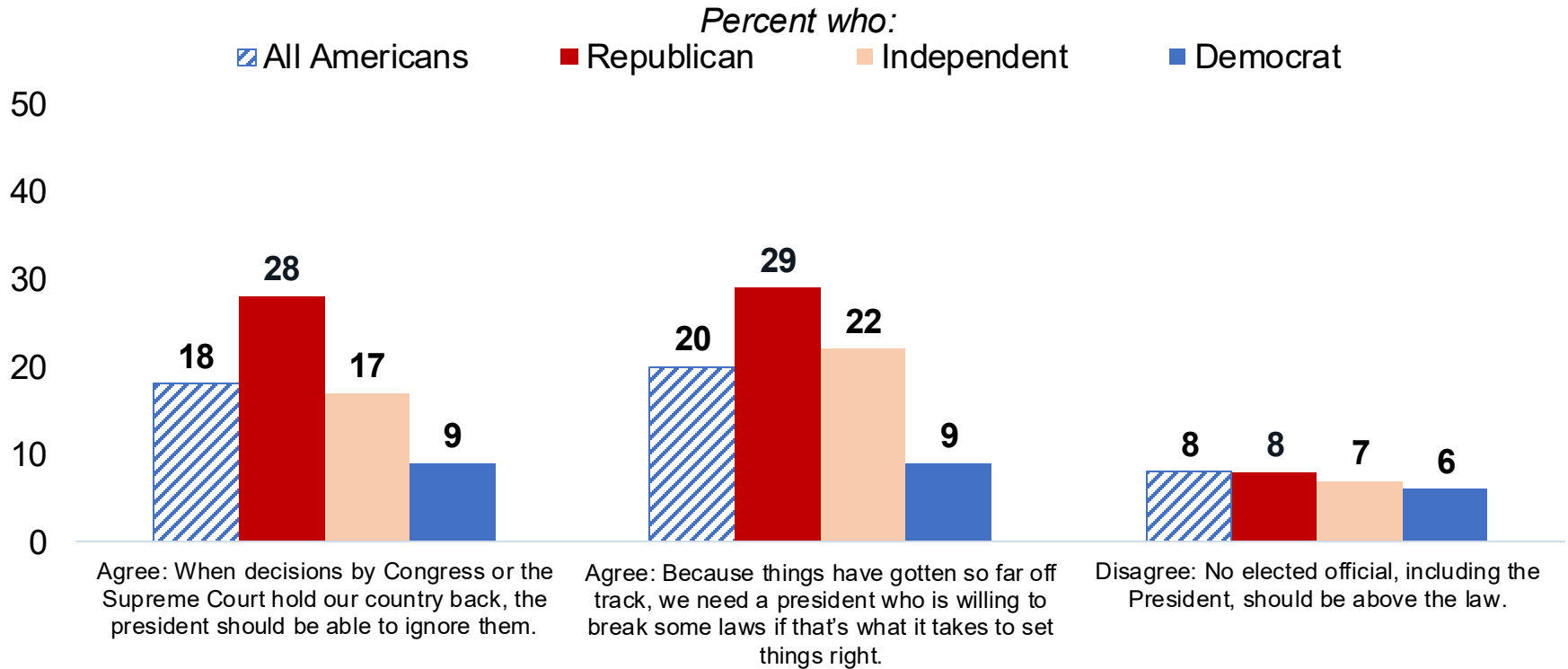
# Support for Postponing Midterm Elections and Allowing Presidents to Serve Three Terms, by Party

# Support for Executive Exemptions to the Rule of Law, by Party

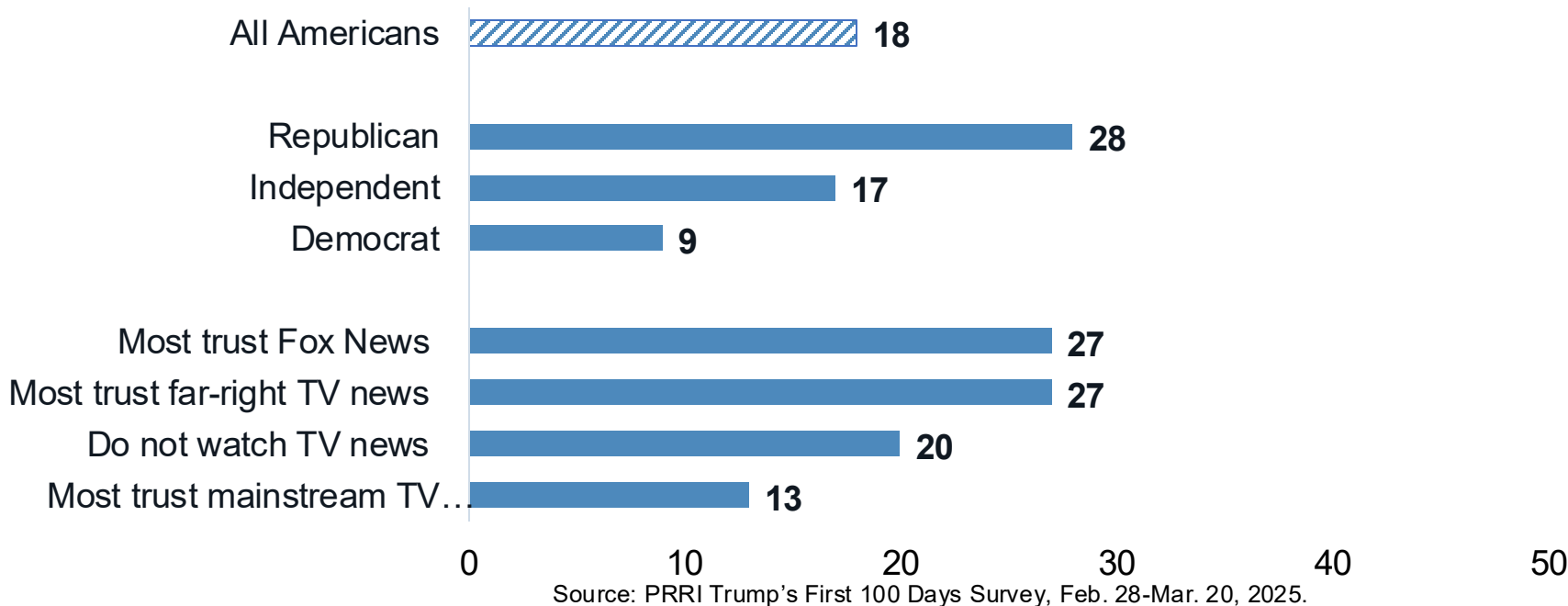

When decisions by Congress or the Supreme Court hold our country back, the president should be able to ignore them.*



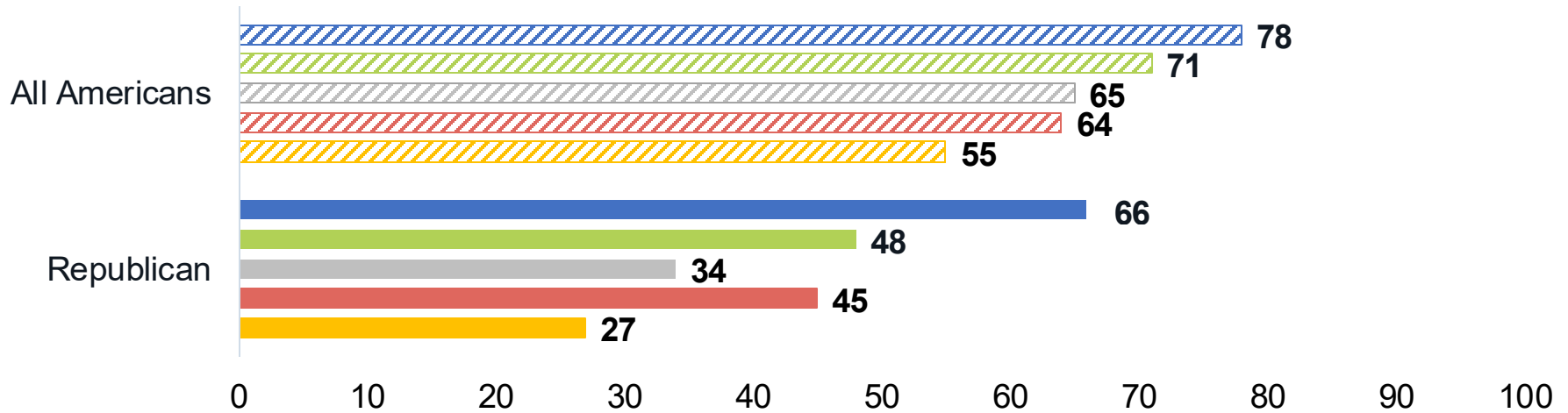

# Opposition to Trump's Executive Orders

## Percent who:

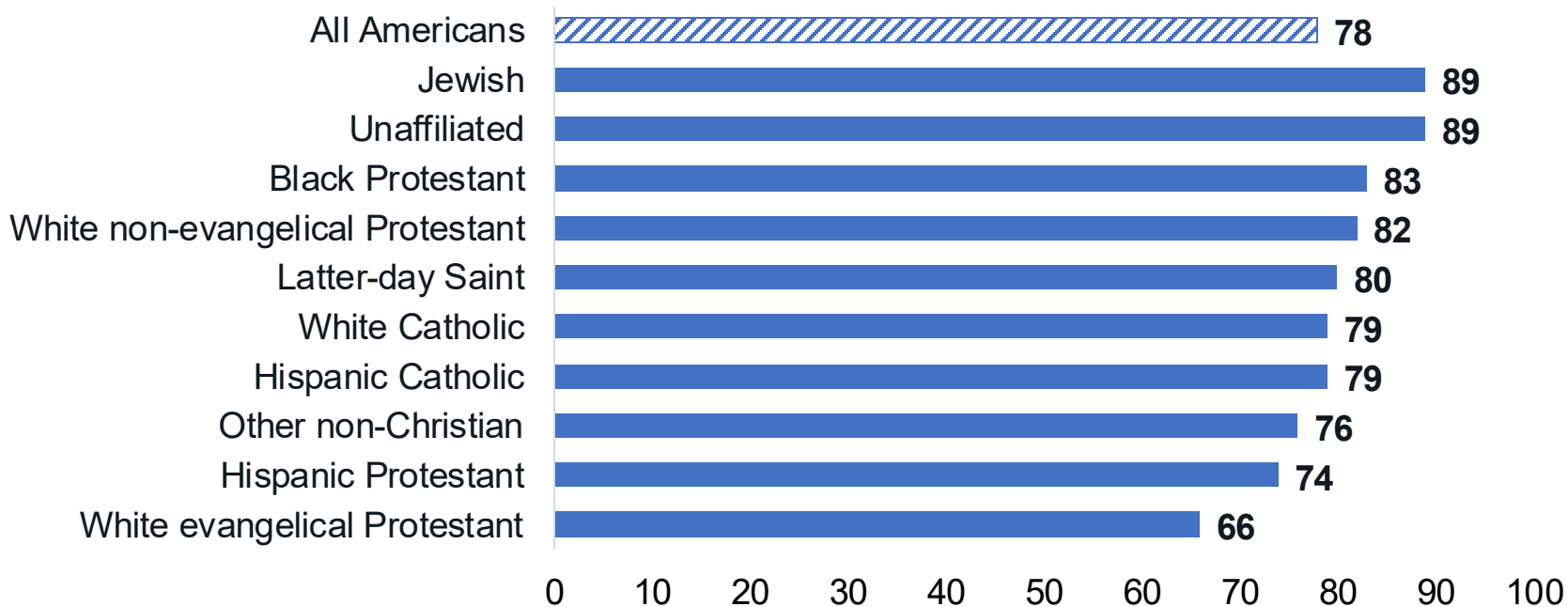
- Oppose: The establishment of a federal task force that focuses exclusively on discrimination against Christians rather than discrimination against all religions.
- Oppose: Closing or drastically shrinking all major federal agencies, if it means things like airline travel, medicine, and water may be less safe.
- Oppose: Implementing new tariffs, or taxes, on imported goods from other countries, if it raises prices for Americans.
- Favor: The U.S. Constitution's existing guarantee that all children who are born in the United States are automatically granted U.S. citizenship.
- Agree: President Trump has overstepped his authority by ordering the mass firing of federal employees across multiple agencies.

*Percent who oppose the establishment of a federal task force that focuses exclusively on discrimination against Christians rather than discrimination against all religions:*

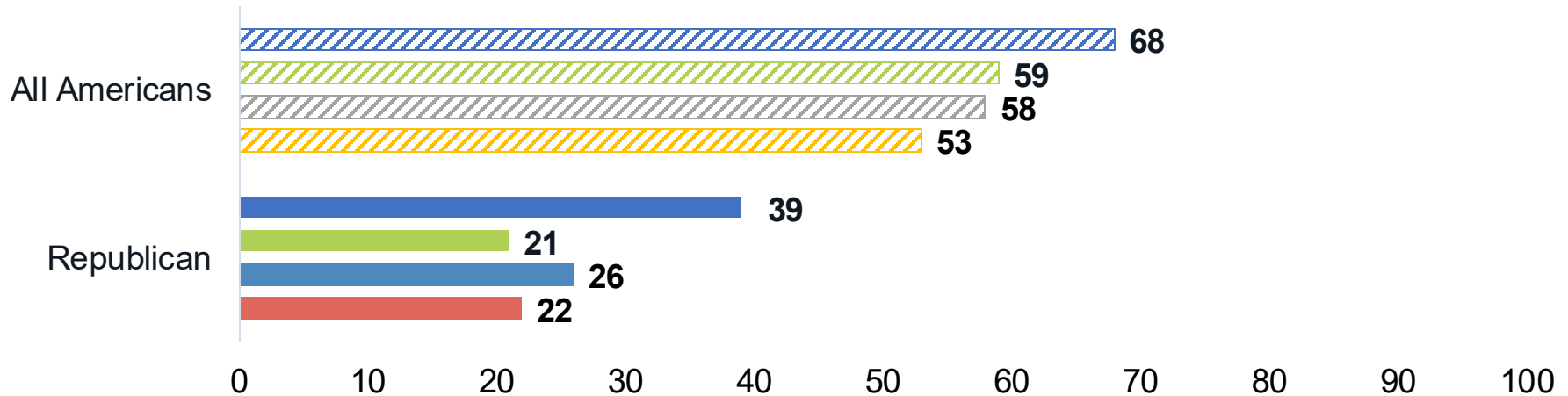

*Percent who:*

- Disapprove: The job Elon Musk is doing within the federal government.
- Unfavorable: View of Elon Musk
- Agree: Elon Musk's attempts to find waste and fraud in federal government agencies are reckless and are doing more harm than good.



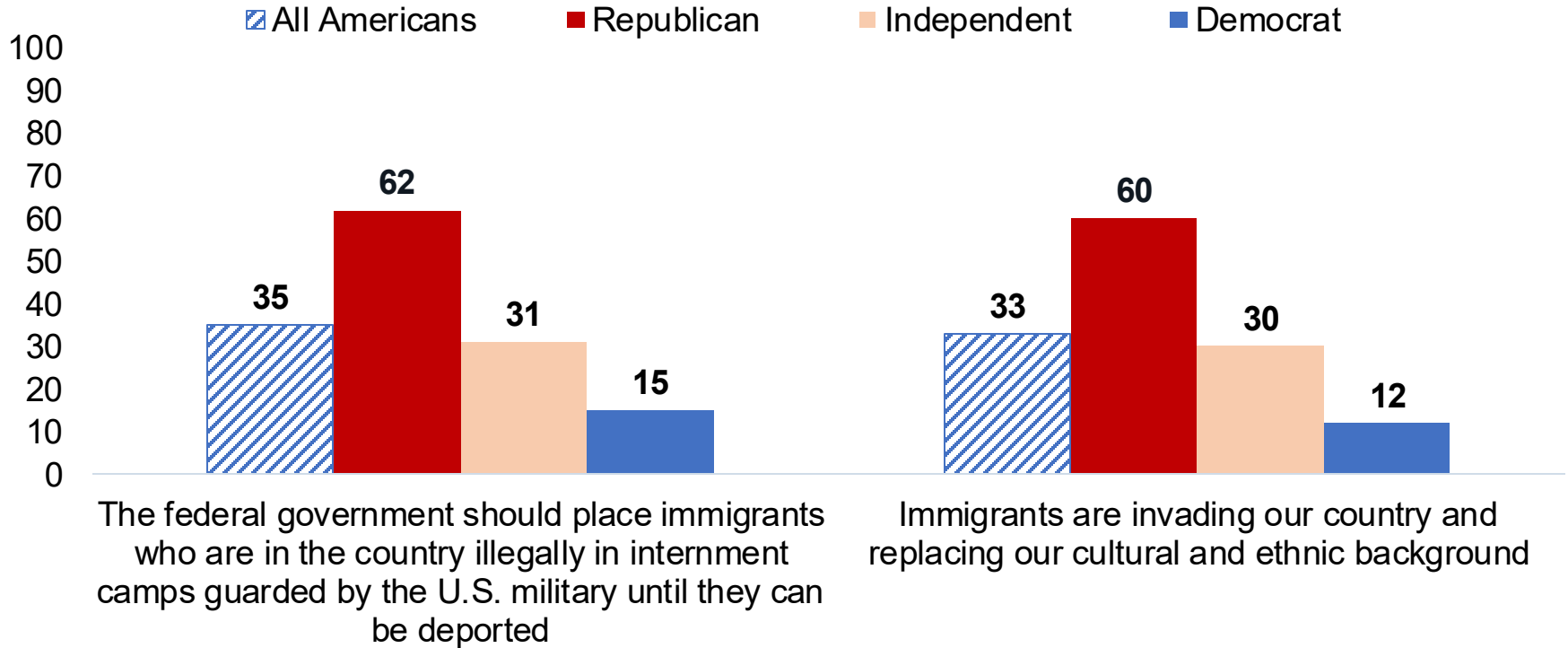

# Views of Immigration Policy and Immigrants, by Party

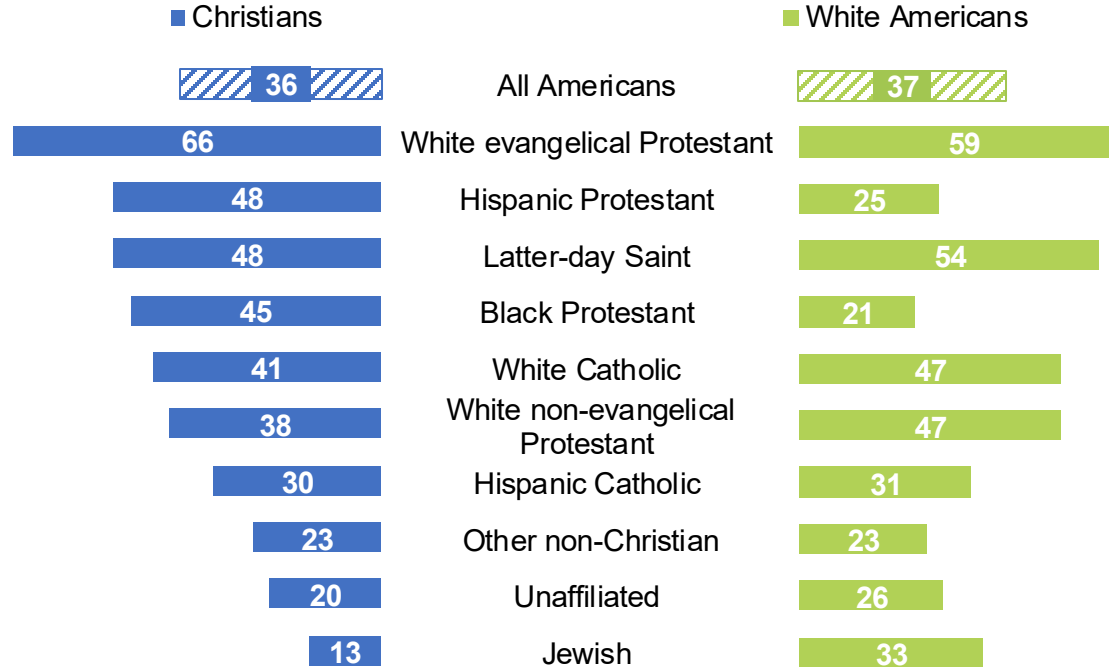

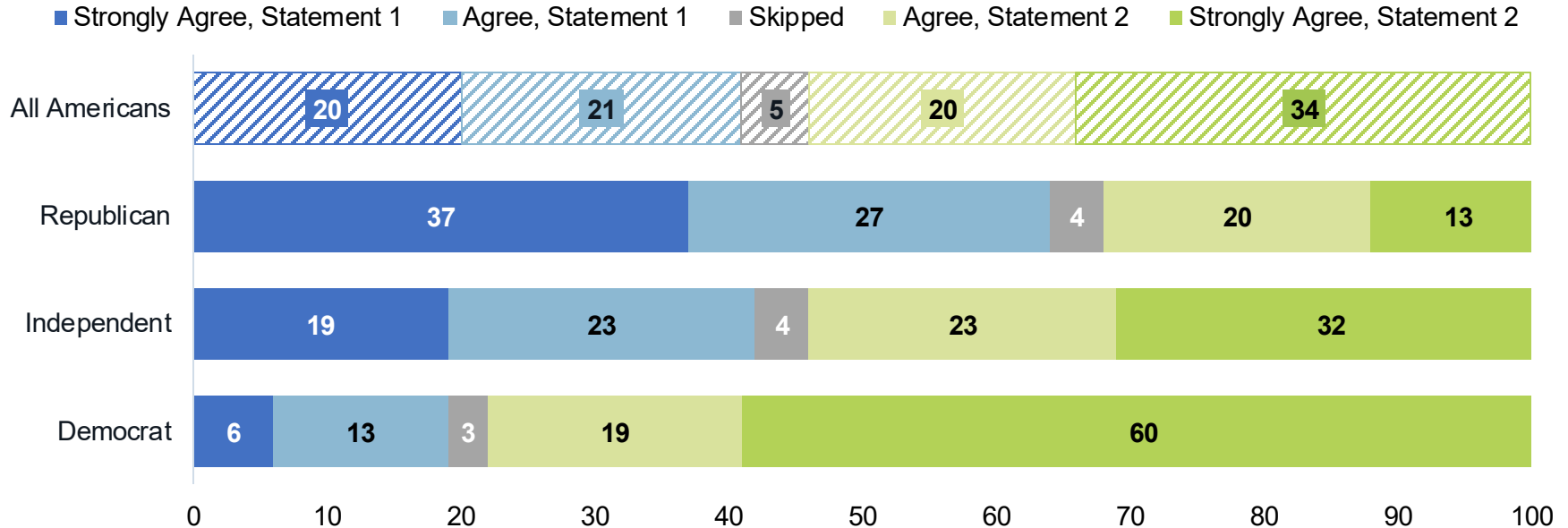


# Perceptions of Diversity Efforts, by Party

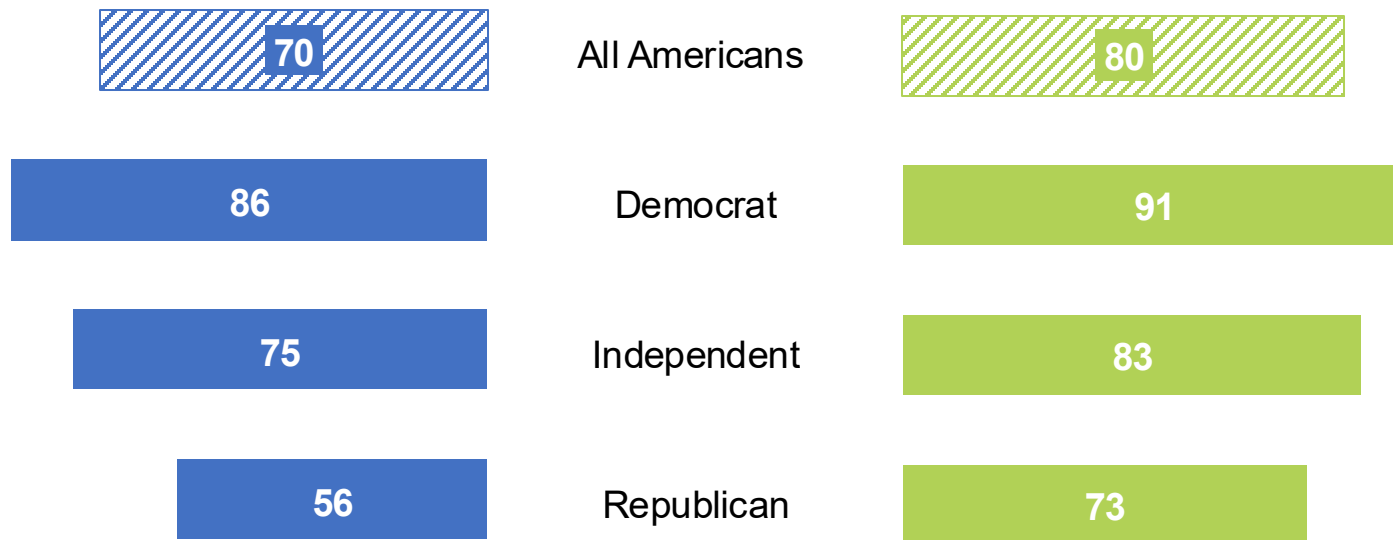

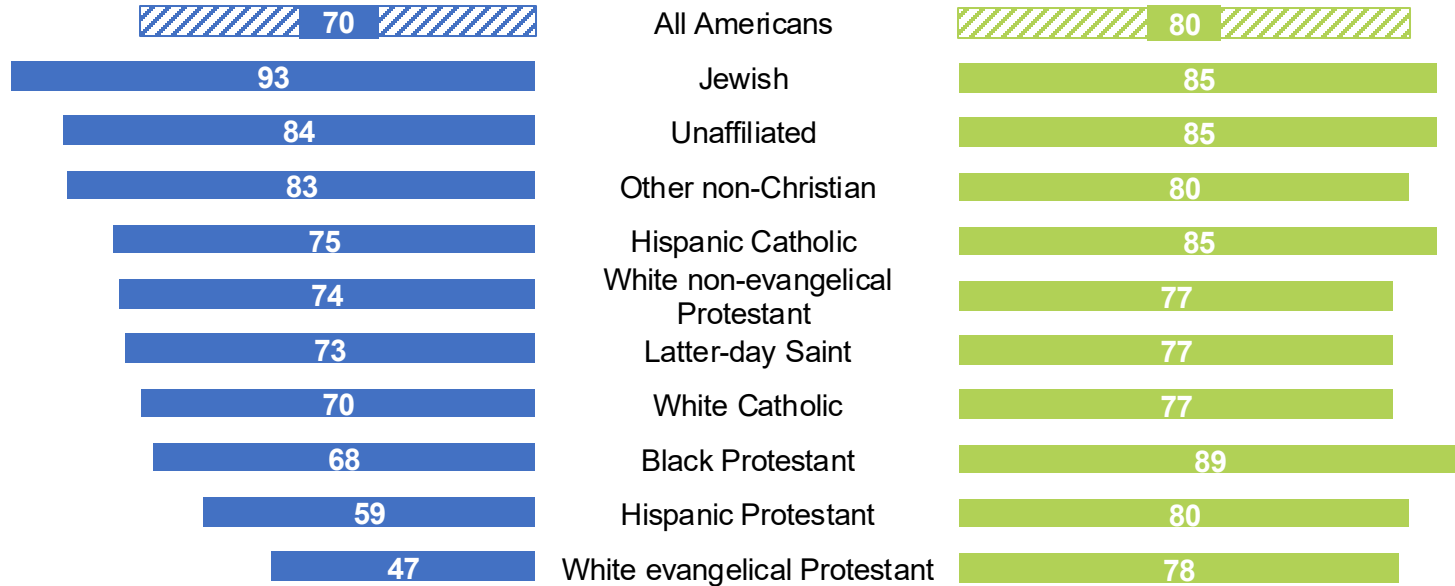

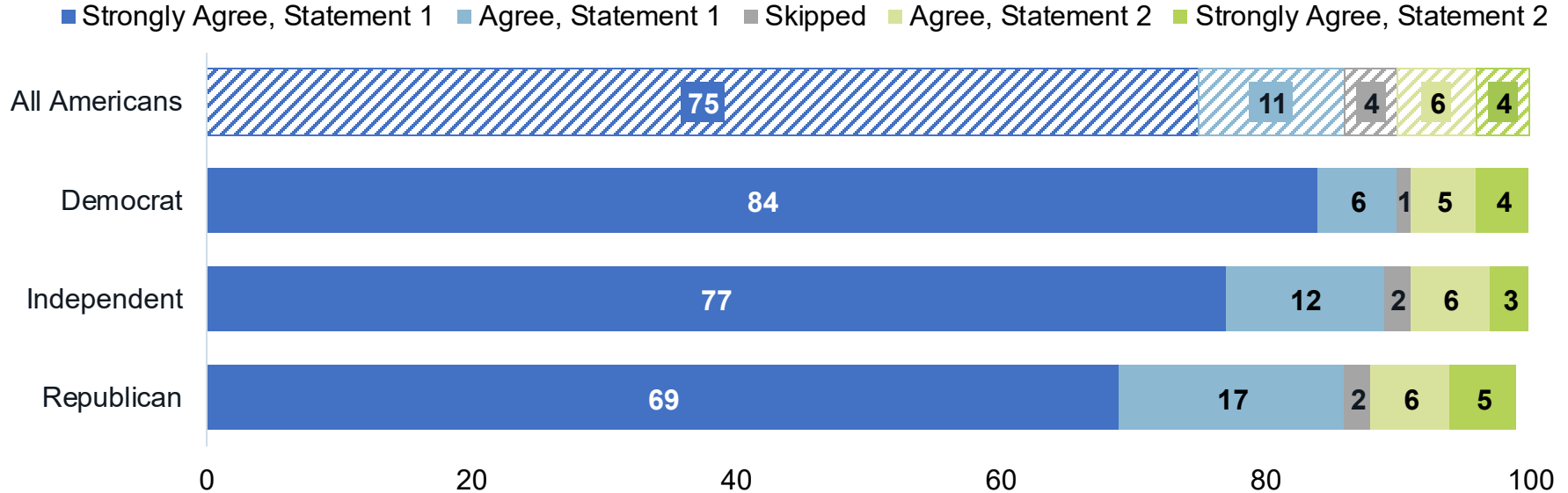
